Building a

Collection Box

There is 5 parts to your box:

- Lid
- Topper
- 2 x side pieces
- Bottom






Assembling the box

<u>The Base</u>

First, bend along all perforated lines so they will fold easily.

Then fold sides A and B (the sides with tabs attached) upright and bring the tabs forward.





The tabs go out at 90 degrees and tuck inside sides C and D to hold the edges together in a nice sturdy rim

Fold sides C and D up and over the tabs and press the edges down into the little slits in the base to fix it all in place.



<u>The Sides</u>

The sides of your box come in two pieces, each with a rectangle (the front/back) and a slightly slanted part (the left/right).





Slide the larger piece (shown here on the right hand side) into the slot on the left hand side. Be sure to keep the small tab outside as shown here. Bend along the perforated lines again, then sit your sides upright next to each other.

Hint: Make sure the text on the outside is right way up – this will help you orient yourself.

Connect your back left corner first.





Then insert the small tab into the slot. Ensuring they are flush together to keep your box safe and secure.

Then pop your completed sides into the base to secure it and keep it upright.

<u>The Top</u>

Like the bottom, the top has edges that stand up from it, with tabs that are sandwiched into the sides next to them to keep the edges together at a right angle.



The difference is that instead of just folding up and down once, the edge panels have a third strip that lies flush against the actual top of the box.

Place your box lid on the sides completing the collection box

The Topper Card

Insert the Topper card into the two slots in the top of the box. Shown circled here.
