2 out of 5 Australian women have called in sick to work due to their period.²

Nearly half of Australian girls have skipped school due to their period.³

About Share the Dignity

In 2015, Share the Dignity was founded after identifying there was a genuine need to provide vulnerable women in our community with essential sanitary products. It was reported that these women were often forced to choose between buying food to eat or buying expensive sanitary items to get through their periods. Women and children, either homeless or in shelters, were having to clean themselves in public toilets and use paper towels to create makeshift sanitary pads.

This is not and should never be okay.

From a grassroots local community initiative to a national charity, Share the Dignity has struck a chord with the Australian public and continues to evolve in order to provide for the needs of at-risk women and children. Working tirelessly with over 6000+ volunteers, the charity has been able to deliver over 4 million packets of pads and tampons and over 800,000 essential filled handbags to Australian women and girls.

Share the Dignity continues to grow with the support of passionate volunteers and the generosity of Australian businesses, ensuring that everyone is afforded the dignity in life that many of us take for granted.

5 Milestones of Menstrual Equity

The 5 milestones focus on removing the obstacles which hinder women and those who menstruate from participating equally in the workplace. This includes providing safe and dignified sanitation facilities, removing the financial burden of period products and personal leave taken, and tackling the shame & stigma around menstruation. By committing to these 5 milestones, you commit to creating a supportive and equitable environment for your employees.

How many have you already achieved?



We believe that no-one should have to go without period products, so we created a machine that dispenses them for free!

At Share the Dignity, we are passionate about empowering and supporting people to live a life of dignity and safety. The state of period poverty in Australia is unacceptable. We acted and created the Dignity Vending Machine (DVM). We have heard too many stories of women, girls and those who menstruate having to resort to using rags or socks or using period products for too long because they could not afford more, which is a major health risk.

Support your employees by installing a Dignity Vending Machine

By installing a commercial DVM or Dispenser not only are you supporting your employees and patrons, but the funds raised through this program increase your impact by helping to fund our mission and the vulnerable communities that we support.



Our Dignity Vending Machines ensure those in need can access free period products at the push of a button.

In February 2024 we installed our very first commercial Dignity Vending Machine at Australia Zoo. Commit to taking meaningful actions through leasing our Dignity Vending Machine (DVM) or purchasing our Dignity Dispensers. The machines dispense a specially designed Period Pack containing 6 tampons and 2 period pads, offering a choice of product and ideally enough to support anyone through a full day of menstruation.

This machine offers the benefit of telemetry records, a remote reporting functionality which will assist you in optimising the location and/or awareness of your machine to get the greatest benefit for your employees and patrons. This will also alert you when stock is low and the machine needs to be refilled.



DIGNITY DISPENSER

Our Commercial Dispenser is designed for small spaces. It can be mounted to any wall, including framework and lower load bearing walls. It showcases a clean, minimal design with its purpose front and centre: providing free period products to those who need them.

The Dignity Dispenser is a great option for small bathrooms or bathrooms without access to power. It dispenses one product at a time with reserve product automatically dropping down.






In a country where almost one million people are living in severe income poverty, ensuring access to basic essentials for the most vulnerable among us is a significant undertaking.
















Hosting a bag packing day at your office or site not only fosters team bonding but also directly impacts the lives of individuals facing adversity.

Help End Period Poverty

Dignity Drive collections are an integral part of our year, held in March and August. Members of the community are encouraged to donate pads, tampons, maternity pads, incontinence pads and period underwear to assist those who would otherwise go without.

Collection points can be found in every Woolworths store across Australia and other businesses can nominate to become collection points.

Our Sheroes and Heroes collect, sort, count and then drop the products direct to our charity partners. Any overflow from an area is collected and sent to other communities where we have not collected enough products.

The 2021 Bloody Big Survey was Australia's LARGEST survey on attitudes and experiences of periods and in 2024 we want to go even bigger!

The Bloody Big Survey provides us with the evidence-based data we need to advocate for change. It proves the social, personal and financial impact of menstruation on Australians and is, to date, the largest body of data in the world on Menstruation! The 2024 Bloody Big Survey will allow us to see if attitudes or experiences have changed over the last 3 years. The survey will be open from March to May.

Our annual flagship campaign, It's in the Bag recognises this issue and aims to supply a gift to a woman, teenage girl or new mum in need, just in time for Christmas. For some, this will be the only gift they receive. The community start buying their bag items months ahead in readiness for the campaign, where complete bags are dropped off at our collection points across all Bunnings stores nationwide.

To assist with the shortfall of *It's In The Bag* donations each year, we have introduced a *Sponsor A Bag* program.

This enables people to support the program from anywhere. Members of the community can make a donation through our website and we will pack bags on their behalf and deliver them directly to our charity partners.

The aim of this program is to help fill the gap of approximately 60,000 bags that we are unable to fulfill. Unfortunately to achieve the full shortfall we would need to raise almost \$2million. As a small charity this is a large financial goal.

Sponsoring an Essentials bag will help provide a bag filled with life's essentials such as period products, shampoo and conditioner, body wash, deodorant, toothbrush and toothpaste.

Since 2015 we've been able to support over 2000 Indigenous charities by donating nearly 1.5 million period products.

In many remote communities across Australia, the cost of period products is much higher due to freight costs and lack of competition in these areas. We distribute thousands of packets of period products to those in need in remote communities across the country to ensure that they are still empowered to take control of their period.
